Welcome to Logan Chieftain Stadium! Logan Chieftain Stadium, or “The Chief”, has been the home to the Logan Chieftains since 2008. Publicly funded by the taxpayers of the Logan-Hocking school district, “The Chief” is a state of the art multi-purpose stadium located on the campus of Logan High School’s Shaw-Davidson Campus, ideally located just off US33 south of Logan.

The 5800+ seat facility plays host to LHS football, soccer, and track and field teams and has hosted multiple OHSAA post-season events.

Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight's Division III, Region 9 championship game features the Champions of the Tri-Valley Conference Ohio Division (Athens) against the Champions of the Columbus City League South Division (Marion-Franklin). Marion-Franklin are searching for a third regional Championship, all won since 2009, while Athens is searching for their first. Athens is in a regional final for the second straight season while the Red Devils are in a regional final for the fourth time in five years.

The **Athens Bulldogs** were unbeaten in the regular season, extending their regular season winning streak to 19-games while capturing a third consecutive TVC-Ohio championship. The Bulldogs were Regional finalists a year ago in Region 12. The Bulldogs have scored 129 points in their first two playoff wins behind the running and throwing of quarterback Joey Burrow.

The **Marion-Franklin Red Devils** have emerged as the top football program in the Columbus City League, qualifying for the playoffs in ten consecutive seasons. Head Coach Brian Haffele is an astounding 94-16 since taking over the program in 2007. MF was a state semi-finalists in 2009 and 2011.

- **Burrow flying high** Athens junior quarterback Joey Burrow, son of Ohio University defensive coordinator Jimmy Burrow, is lighting up scoreboards and re-writing record books while leading the Athens Bulldogs to new heights. In his career, Burrow has passed for 6,624 yards and 93 touchdowns while completing 391 of 576 passes with only 13 interceptions thrown. He's also rushed for 1,364 yards and 22 touchdowns on 251 rushes. Including a 64-yard TD pass he caught earlier this season from Ryan Luehrman, Burrow has accounted for 8,052 yards of offense and accounted for 116 total touchdowns, all while leading the Bulldogs to a 23-2 overall record. Burrow has already received a scholarship offer from Ohio University while schools from across the country have expressed interest in the talented junior.
- **Athletes everywhere** While the Athens Bulldogs have gotten used to being outmanned in the trenches during the postseason, the Red Devils may create the biggest mismatch that Athens has seen yet. On offense, MF's offensive line averages 262 pounds per man from tackle to tackle and is anchored by massive tackles Devante Collins (6-0, 322) and Martesse Patterson (6-5, 299). Despite the giant bodies up front, what might stand out even more for the Red Devils is the speed of their skill players. Led by quarterback Justin Tyler and slot back Landon Yeartie, MFHS's offense is full of speedy athletes to run behind that giant offensive line.
- **Stout Defense** Marion-Franklin's defense has smothered opponents in 2013, holding them to fewer than 12 points per game. In fact, the MF defense has not allowed a single point in the first quarter all season. Brookhaven dented the scoreboard in the first quarter in week two, but those 2 points came from a safety. Red Devil opponents have only scored 42 first half points all season, an average of 3.5 per game.
- **Tonight's Venue** Tonight is the seventh neutral site playoff game held at Logan Chieftain Stadium, with the favored seed holding a 4-2 record. St. Clairsville's 59 points in 2012 are a stadium record and Columbus Ready's 17-0 win over Portsmouth West in 2008 marks the only playoff shut-out. Athen's 55-52 win over Tri-Valley was the first overtime playoff game at the stadium. Logan Chieftain Stadium has also hosted two Logan Chieftain playoff games with Logan beating Dublin Jerome 23-7 in 2008 and Canal Winchester 30-7 in 2009.
