**Welcome to Logan Chieftain Stadium!** Logan Chieftain Stadium, or “The Chief”, has been the home to the Logan Chieftains since 2008. Publicly funded by the taxpayers of the Logan-Hocking school district, “The Chief” is a state of the art multi-purpose stadium located on the campus of Logan High School’s Shaw-Davidson Campus, ideally located just off US33 south of Logan.

The 5800+ seat facility plays host to LHS football, soccer, and track and field teams and has hosted multiple OHSAA post-season events.

## **Game Notes:**

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight's Division III, Region 9 semi-final features the Champions of the Tri-Valley Conference Ohio Division Athens Bulldogs against the Muskingum Valley League Champion Tri-Valley Scotties. It is believed to be the first ever gridiron meeting between the two schools.

The **Athens Bulldogs** were unbeaten in the regular season, extending their regular season winning streak to 19-games while capturing a third consecutive TVC-Ohio championship. The Bulldogs were Regional finalists a year ago in Region 12. The Bulldogs racked up 74 points last week against Logan Elm, the second highest point total in Ohio during the weekend's first round games. Ohio University recruit Joey Burrow leads a high-flying Athens offense averaging 58.6 points per game.

The **Tri-Valley Scotties** rebounded from a humbling 52-7 mid-season loss to Division II AP Poll Champion Zanesville to finish 8-2 in the regular season including a perfect 8-0 mark in the Muskingum Valley League for the second straight season. The Scotties have won three-straight MVL championships. Tri-Valley knocked off visiting New Philadelphia 47-21 to move to 3-0 all-time in home playoff games. The Tri-Valley defense held NP's Jamal Johnson to only 8 yards on 7 carries. Johnson had rushed for at least 100 yards and scored in every game prior to Friday night.

- **Burrow flying high ....** Athens junior quarterback Joey Burrow, son of Ohio University defensive coordinator Jimmy Burrow, is lighting up scoreboards and re-writing record books while leading the Athens Bulldogs to new heights. In his career, Burrow has passed for 6,340 yards and 89 touchdowns while completing 372 of 554 passes with only 13 interceptions thrown. He's also rushed for 1,275 yards and 20 touchdowns on 231 rushes. Including a 64-yard TD pass he caught earlier this season from Ryan Luehrman, Burrow has accounted for 7,679 yards of offense and accounted for 110 total touchdowns, all while leading the Bulldogs to a 22-2 overall record. Burrow has already received a scholarship offer from Ohio University while schools from across the country have expressed interest in the talented junior.
- **Three-headed Scottie ....** Tri-Valley's offense is paced by the three headed monster of quarterback Brock Fargus and running backs Daniel Scott and Logan Bash. Although known for its spread offense and passing game, the 2013 Scotties have been an excellent running team, gaining 257 yards per game on the ground. Scott (874, 14 TDs), Fargus (851, 9 TDs), and Bash (616, 10 TDs) have spread the running load out evenly making the offense extremely hard to defend. Senior tackle Collin Prouty, a Kent State University commit, leads TV's dominant offensive line.
- **Tonight's Venue ....** Tonight is the sixth neutral site playoff game held at Logan Chieftain Stadium, with the favored seed holding a 3-2 record. St. Clairsville's 59 points in 2012 are a stadium record and Columbus Ready's 17-0 win over Portsmouth West in 2008 marks the only playoff shut-out. Logan Chieftain Stadium has also hosted two Logan Chieftain playoff games with Logan beating Dublin Jerome 23-7 in 2008 and Canal Winchester 30-7 in 2009.
- **First visit, sort of ....** Both Athens and Tri-Valley are making their first visits to Logan Chieftain Stadium, but both have their own history playing in Logan. Athens was a long-time member of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League, playing 45 games in total in Logan, winning 13. Tri-Valley, meanwhile, was the last opponent Logan ever faced at old Bill Sauer Field. Tri-Valley defeated Logan 31-26 in a first round Division II, Region 7 playoff game.
- **Riding the fence ....** Athens (3-3) and Tri-Valley (6-6) both carry .500 all-time playoff records into tonight's contest, meaning that one school will fall on either side of the .500 mark in the post-season. While both schools have been to a Regional Final (TV in 2011, Athens in 2012), both are also hoping to have a chance to win their first ever Regional Championship next week.
