Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** Tonight marks the 30th meeting between the Nelsonville-York Buckeyes and the Logan Chieftains, and the 85th time that schools representing the communities of Nelsonville and Logan have met on the gridiron. The Chieftains were 45-6-4 against the Nelsonville Greyhounds from 1913-1966 and are 21-8 against the Buckeyes of Nelsonville-York post consolidation in 1967. Despite the lopsided history between the two, the Buckeyes have won the last two games by a combined score of 92-6. The 2011 game was the first meeting since 2002.

The Buckeyes are 2-2; opening with losses to state ranked Trimble (40-0) and perennial power and 2012 state runner-up Newark Catholic (34-16) but rebounding with dominating wins over Berne Union (44-21) and River Valley (36-0).

Logan is 1-3 having defeated Newark 32-27 for their first non-league win since 2009 but dropping decisions to Lancaster (57-7), Teays Valley (26-13), and Loudonville (31-7).

- **If we win tomorrow, that's called a winning streak** Despite success against the Chieftains in the early-'80s, and mid-'90s, Nelsonville-York is yet to record a three-game winning streak against Logan. History will be made tonight if the Buckeyes can pick up a win following back-to-back victories in 2011 (42-0) and 2012 (50-0).

The Buckeyes won back-to-back games in their state championship winning season of 1981 (40-0) and 1982 (35-13), but the two schools did not play again until 1986. Logan won the 1980 game by a slim 7-6 margin. The Buckeyes also won back-to-back games in 1996 (28-21) and 1997 (27-17), but the Chieftains edged NYHS 34-29 in 1998. Logan beat N-Y 21-18 in 1995.

- **2012 Round Up** Logan lost a pair of hard breaking non-league games against Northland (26-32, overtime) and Newark (32-35) and had a pair of embarrassing losses to close the non-league (Nelsonville-York, 50-0) and league (Warren, 49-8) seasons. The Chieftains ended up the season 2-8 overall with a pair of SEOAL wins over Portsmouth (35-14) and Chillicothe (28-7). Running back Cory McCarty was a third team All-Ohio selection despite battling injuries the second half of the season.

Nelsonville-York started 0-2 against Trimble and Newark Catholic, but rebounded to reel off 7 straight wins, including a 50-0 shellacking of rival Logan, before falling to Athens 42-21 in week 10. The Buckeyes just missed out on a playoff berth finishing 9th in Division V, Region 19.

- **Meet the new boss** Logan's Bill Burke was named the school's 30th head football coach during the off-season. Burke is a graduate of Lancaster High School and played football at the University of Akron. Burke previously coached as an assistant at Hilliard Darby and was the head coach at Buckeye High School in Medina County.
- **SEOAL** The Chieftains are founding members of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League, and have been members continuously since 1925. Logan, winners of more titles than any school in the history of the league, will compete with Gallia Academy, Jackson, Portsmouth, and Warren for the championship.

Nelsonville High School was a founding member of the SEOAL and Nelsonville-York was a member from 1967-1969.

A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Gallipolis as the favorite to repeat as Champions after the Blue Devils 5-0 league record in 2011. Logan was picked to finish third behind the Jackson Ironmen and just ahead of Warren and Portsmouth.
