## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight is the first meeting ever between Logan High School and Loudonville High School. The Redbirds are making their second longest road trip in school history, and are the second team from Ashland County to ever face the Chieftains (Logan played a home and home with Ashland High School in 1987 and 1988). Logan will travel to Loudonville in 2014.

The Redbirds are 3-0 with resounding wins over Smithville, Crestview, and Hillsdale by a combined score of 135-19. Loudonville made their first playoff appearance in 12 years last season and look poised to return to the playoff this season.

Logan defeated Newark 32-27 last week, their first win of the season. It was Logan's first non-league win since the 2009 season. Logan opened with losses to Lancaster (57-7) and Teays Valley (26-13).

- **First win in the bag ....** First year Logan head coach Billy Burke won his first game as the Chieftain mentor last Friday, beating Newark 32-27. Here are the last five first wins by LHS coaches:

- **Legendary coach was a Redbird ....** Despite being the first ever meeting between the two schools, Loudonville and Logan share one key connection. Tom Bender, coach of the Chieftains from 1936-1941, was a native of Loudonville and graduated from Ashland College in 1929. Bender was an inaugural inductee into the LHS Athletic Hall of Fame in 1976. Bender compiled a 38-18-1 record, won a pair of SEOAL championships (1939, 1941), and coached Logan's first two HM All-Ohio football players Bob McBride (1939) and Bill "Mutt" Bryan (1940).
- **2012 Round Up ....** Logan lost a pair of hard breaking non-league games against Northland (26-32, overtime) and Newark (32-35) and had a pair of embarrassing losses to close the non-league (Nelsonville-York, 50-0) and league (Warren, 49-8) seasons. The Chieftains ended up the season 2-8 overall with a pair of SEOAL wins over Portsmouth (35-14) and Chillicothe (28-7). Running back Cory McCarty was a third team All-Ohio selection despite battling injuries the second half of the season.

Loudonville ran up an 8-2 regular season record on their way to the OHSAA playoffs but were beaten in their first round game by Bucyrus Wynford 24-0. Loudonville's three losses were all to playoff teams (Danville, Johnstown-Monroe). The Redbirds beat playoff qualifier Hillsdale during the regular season.

- **Meet the new boss ....** Logan's Bill Burke was named the school's 30<sup>th</sup> head football coach during the off-season. Burke is a graduate of Lancaster High School and played football at the University of Akron. Burke previously coached as an assistant at Hilliard Darby and was the head coach at Buckeye High School in Medina County.
- **SEOAL ....** The Chieftains are founding members of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League, and have been members continuously since 1925. Logan, winners of more titles than any school in the history of the league, will compete with Gallia Academy, Jackson, Portsmouth, and Warren for the championship.

A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Gallipolis as the favorite to repeat as Champions after the Blue Devils 5-0 league record in 2011. Logan was picked to finish third behind the Jackson Ironmen and just ahead of Warren and Portsmouth.
