Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up** This will be the ninth match-up between the two schools since the rivalry renewed in 2004. Prior to that the two schools had not met on the gridiron since 1957. Lancaster won the first four meetings during the last decade before Logan won back to back games in 2008 and 2009. Lancaster has won the last three years, including a 42-7 margin last year, and holds the all-time series advantage 31-8-4.
- **2012 Meeting** Lancaster dominated Logan in last year's meeting, rolling up a 42-7 win behind a dominating ground game that accumulated 438 rushing yards. That number is the fifth most ever allowed by a Logan defense and the second most to a Lancaster team after the 2006 10-0 Gale squad ran up 460. Tight end Ryan Thomas had a pair of touchdown catches and Andrew Shisler had a 73-yard touchdown run for the Gales. Isaac Schmeltzer had a 6-yard touchdown catch for Logan.
- **2012 Round Up** Logan lost a pair of hard breaking non-league games against Northland (26-32, overtime) and Newark (32-35) and had a pair of embarrassing losses to close the non-league (Nelsonville-York, 50-0) and league (Warren, 8-49) seasons. The Chieftains ended up the season 2-8 overall with a pair of SEOAL wins over Portsmouth (35-14) and Chillicothe (28-7). Running back Cory McCarty was a third team All-Ohio selection despite battling injuries the second half of the season.

Lancaster finished below .500 for the first time since the 2000 season and bookended a difficult season with wins over rivals Logan (49-7) and Newark (50-21) in the first and last weeks.

- **Meet the new boss** Logan's Bill Burke was named the school's 30th head football coach during the off-season. Burke is a graduate of Lancaster High School adding another storyline to this series. Burke played football at the University of Akron and previously coached as an assistant at Hilliard Darby and was the head coach at Buckeye High School in Medina County.
- **OCC Ohio** Lancaster will compete in one of the toughest conferences in the state again in 2012, the OCC-Ohio. The division includes former Chieftain opponents Gahanna-Lincoln, Reynoldsburg, and Pickerington North along with the Chiefs week three opponent Newark. Other members are Grove City, Groveport-Madison, and Pickerington Central.
- **SEOAL** The Chieftains are founding members of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League, and have been members continuously since 1925. Logan, winners of more titles than any school in the history of the league, will compete with Gallia Academy, Jackson, Portsmouth, and Warren for the championship.

A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Gallipolis as the favorite to repeat as Champions after the Blue Devils 5-0 league record in 2011. Logan was picked to finish third behind the Jackson Ironmen and just ahead of Warren and Portsmouth.
