## Game Notes:

- **Tonight's Match-up ....** Tonight is the first ever meeting on the gridiron between Teays Valley High School and Logan High School. The Vikings, led by fifth year man Steve Evans, have finished 5-5 in each of the last three seasons while Logan, led by first year head coach Billy Burkes, have been 3-7, 1-9, and 2-8 over the last three years. TV is 1-0 after a 52-22 drubbing of Westfall last week while the Chieftains are 0-1 following 57-7 thumping against Lancaster.

TVHS is the third school from the Mid-State League to face Logan in the last 20 years following Hamilton Twp. (2008, '09) and Canal Winchester (2009 playoffs). Logan is 17-17-4 all-time against teams currently members of the MSL.

- **Home Opener ....** Billy Burke's makes his home coaching debut for the Chieftains tonight against Teays Valley. Kelly Wolfe, Dale Amyx, and Steve Coate made their Chieftain debuts at home while Burke, Clarence Perry, and Dave Snipes all started with games on the road.

Amyx, Wolfe, and Burke all opened their Chieftain careers with losses to teams coached by Rob Carpenter. Wolfe and Burke lost against Carpenter's Lancaster teams while Amyx lost against a Carpenter coached New Lexington Panther team.

- **2012 Round Up ....** Logan lost a pair of hard breaking non-league games against Northland (26-32, overtime) and Newark (32-35) and had a pair of embarrassing losses to close the non-league (Nelsonville-York, 50-0) and league (Warren, 49-8) seasons. The Chieftains ended up the season 2-8 overall with a pair of SEOAL wins over Portsmouth (35-14) and Chillicothe (28-7). Running back Cory McCarty was a third team All-Ohio selection despite battling injuries the second half of the season.

Teays Valley were 5-5 for the third straight season and finished in a 4-2 way tie for second in the MSL-Buckeye with a 4-3 league record.

- **Meet the new boss ....** Logan's Bill Burke was named the school's 30<sup>th</sup> head football coach during the off-season. Burke is a graduate of Lancaster High School and played football at the University of Akron. Burke previously coached as an assistant at Hilliard Darby and was the head coach at Buckeye High School in Medina County.
- **Hall of Fame ....** Four LHS graduates will be honored during tonight's pregame festivities after being added to the LHS Athletic Hall of Fame. A dinner and ceremony were held last night in the LHS Cafeteria to honor women's sports pioneer Sue McBroom (1973), three sport standout Jim Redd (1990), girls basketball great Tami Hampshire (1994), and All-Ohio linebacker Matt Mong (2002).
- **SEOAL ....** The Chieftains are founding members of the Southeastern Ohio Athletic League, and have been members continuously since 1925. Logan, winners of more titles than any school in the history of the league, will compete with Gallia Academy, Jackson, Portsmouth, and Warren for the championship.

A panel of SEOAL Media representatives selected Gallipolis as the favorite to repeat as Champions after the Blue Devils 5-0 league record in 2011. Logan was picked to finish third behind the Jackson Ironmen and just ahead of Warren and Portsmouth.
